FREE STATE LADIES GOLF UNION

Tournament conditions:

- The tournament is open to any amateur golfer affiliated to WGSA, or any amateur golfer affiliated to a governing body recognized by WGSA.
- 2. The Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such local rules approved by the Tournament Committee.
- 3. The Tournament Committee shall consist of the FSLGU Executive Committee. The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and conditions of the event at any time, including starting times. All disputes shall be settled by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final. Any dispute/ protest must be lodged within 15 minutes of completion of the round. This information may be requested in writing.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right not to accept any late entries, and to limit the field by eliminating in handicap order, from the highest handicap, followed by date of receipt of entry. Handicaps on the first day of the Championship will determine the division in which a player competes. Handicap verification maybe requested. If a change in Division has occurred since the close of entries, the player will play where drawn in the published timesheet for the first round, but compete in the correct division. Handicaps on the first day of play shall apply throughout the tournament, and will be applied to calculate all nett results. Nett Events: Only players with an official WGSA Handicap are eligible for nett events.
- 5. NO REFUNDS IF ENTRANT WITHDRAWS.
- 6. No motorized cars are allowed for A & B divisions. Spectators must keep a distance of 30m form players at all times.
- 7. DRAW: The tournament draw is seeded. TIME OF STARTING: Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 6.3)
- 8. CADDIES: Local caddies will be allowed. Outside and guest caddies will be allowed.
- 9. Unauthorized use of cellphones on the course is a breach of etiquette. Offenders will be warned and may be subjected to penalties under Rule 33.7
- 10. Dress Code: Smart Casual in the clubhouse and appropriate wear on the course.
- 11. WGSA's Code of Conduct will apply throughout.
- 12. Players are requested to be on the tee 10 minutes before Tee Off Time.
- 13. Weather Delays and suspension of play: One prolonged siren discontinue immediately, resume play two short sirens.
- 14. Cancellation of a round in the event of play being delayed or declared nul and void for any round of the tournament, additional play will be at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. If due to adverse weather conditions, commencement of play cannot be resumed, a result will be declared over the number of rounds completed by all players.
- 15. In the event of a tie in the Open Championship Division, there will be a Sudden Death Play Off. (Holes 16, 17 and 18.) In all the other Divisions, the winners will be joint holders of the Trophy, but the FSLGU Count Out Rule will apply for the prizes. (Last 18, 9, 6, 3 & 1)
- 16. FSLGU cannot be held responsible for any damage, loss (Personal or other), harm or injury sustained. This includes physical and emotional, and any acts of God (lightning).
- 17. Prize Giving: will take place after play on Sunday,
- 18. Anti Doping: A competitor shall not make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Attention of competitors is drawn to the prescribed list of drugs issued by the South African Institute for Drug Free Sport. Web Site www.drugfreesport.org.za. Any competitor infringing this condition or refusing to take a test if asked to do so, may be disqualified.
