"I believe there is no right or wrong way to swing the club, but rather an efficient, repeatable way and an inefficient. The golf swing should be as simple as possible with no unnecessary movements. The golf club swings on a plane with a square club face that is comfortable to the student and matches their body type. The body should be relaxed and free of tension to maximize the students' power within."
