Conditions of Entry

The 2018 Club Championship is open to all male and female members of Stellenbosch Golf Club and subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee. The Championship will take place on the 05 & 06 May 2018 and the field will be restricted to a 150 players. (Male & Female Players)

Tournament Regulations

1. The championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as published in the "R&A Decisions on the Rules of Golf" publication 2016 - 2017 and in accordance with the Local rules of the Club, approved by the Tournament Committee.
2. There will be **ONE CLUB LENGTH PLACING** during the championship on all closely mown areas through the green.
3. Decisions on any discrepancies and rulings will be made by the Tournament Committee. Decisions made by the Tournament Committee is final.
4. If a player is unsure of a ruling during play: Two balls must be played under Rule 3-3. A final decision will be made by the Tournament Committee after completion of the round.
5. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change or amend rules and regulations during the championship, should it be required.

Competition Format

1. The championship will be a Stroke Play event. The player recording the lowest gross score in each division will determine the divisional winners.
2. The A Division will play from the YELLOW markers. The B & C Divisions will play from the WHITE tee markers. (Blue tee marker players will also be required to play from the white markers as per the SAGA Handicap Guide)
3. The Ladies will play of from the RED markers
4. Entries must be done in the pro shop. Only Written entries will be accepted and must be received before or on the 02 May 2017.
5. A Division (Open - Handicap Ballot) played over 54 holes (Saturday & Sunday)
6. B Division (6-16) played over 36 holes (Saturday & Sunday)
7. C Division (17-36) played over 18 holes (Saturday)
8. Seniors (over the age of 50) will compete in their respected divisions
9. Should there be an oversubscription in the A Division the lowest handicap players will have preference.
10. The field for the club championships will be limited to 150 players. In the A Division a ballot system will be used. In the B & C Division it will be the first entries received in each division.
11. Ladies Division will be as follows:
 - A) Silver-Division 0 to 18 Handicaps over 36 holes (Saturday & Sunday)
 - B). B-Bronze-Division 19 to 36 Handicaps over 36 holes (Saturday & Sunday)
 - C). Seniors Division – as point 7 of the Rules & Regulations

Ties

In the event of a tie for first position in all Gross divisions, a sudden death play-off will determine the winner; no count out procedure will apply. The match will start on a hole determined by the Tournament Committee.

In the event of players that tie on the same score for additional prizes, the prize money will be shared amongst the players.
