INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are members of a Golf Club affiliated to the Southern Cape Golf Union (SCGU), Womens Golf South Africa (WGSA), or a governing body recognized by WGSA, and who have a handicap of **36 (Thirty-six)** or less as assessed in terms of the WGSA Course Rating and Handicapping System.

Entries

Entries will be limited to 84 players. Should more than 84 entries be received, entries will be reduced by ballot in terms of higher handicaps.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over one day. 18 Holes will be played on Sunday morning 10th June 2018 at Oubaai Golf Club, and the Divisions will be as follow:

A Division (9 and under) will play Medal,

B Division (10 – 18) will play Medal,

C Division (19 – 36) will play Individual Stableford.

In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death play-off will take place over hole 1 until the winner is determined. All other count outs will be done using the R&A Tournament count out method. This will be done via the Albatros Scoring Program that will be used during the 2018 Order of Merit season. SCGU will also be sending an official scorer to this Womens Open.

Entry Procedure

Please enter online via or website www.scgu.co.za/women/. Alternatively, entry forms are obtainable from Oubaai Golf Club, Secretaries of Affiliated Golf Clubs, and the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Closing date

Entries close at 12h00 on Wednesday 6th June 2018. **Late entries and entries without payment or payment arrangement will not be accepted.**

Withdrawals

Only written cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made.

Draw & Starting Times

The draw will be conducted by the Southern Cape Golf Union. Shotgun start at 09h30, and players will be seeded according to handicap, and play in 4 Balls. Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 6-3. The draw will be emailed to the Womens Golf Division Database; will be available at Oubaai Golf Club, the Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Womens Golf Division web site www.scgu.co.za/women/ by Thursday 7th June 2018. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Sunday 10th June 2018.

The registration area will be located in the lounge area of the Club House.

***Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.**

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Golf Carts

PLEASE NOTE that it will be compulsory for all competing players to ride on a golf cart. Cart fees are included in your entry fee, and this ensures that the playing field is fair. Players without a RSA driver's license will be drawn with a valid driver's license holder. **All competing players must sign Oubaai Golf Club's golf cart Indemnity Form.**

Dress Code

- a) Soft spikes.
- b) Golf specific and recognised golf attire will be allowed.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M.D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

***Penalty for breach of Rule 14-3:** First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification

Prize Giving

The Southern Cape Golf Union hereby requests that all competing players please attend the prize giving on Sunday 10th June 2018. Failure to attend will lead to players forfeiting their prize. Your respect towards the above request will be much appreciated.

General

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by Oubaai Golf Club by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA, WGSA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including;

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.

- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA, WGSa & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
