#### 1. Divisions

Men – A Division Handicaps 9 and under Ladies A Division 0 TO 9 (Medal) Handicaps 10-18 **B** Division **B** Division 10 to 18 (Medal) C Division Handicaps 19+ (IPS) C Division 19 to 26 (Medal) Masters (IPS) **D** Division 27 to 36 (IPS)

#### 2. Tee Markers

#### 3. Format

All participants play stroke (medal) except the Ladies D Division and the Men C Division and Masters Division who will play Stableford off full club handicaps and will participate in the divisions according to their handicaps as at Friday morning 23<sup>th</sup> March.

# 4. Distance measuring devices

Are allowed provided only direct distance functions are used.

# 5. Entry Fee

Entry fee is non-refundable after day 1 draw has been published. Entry forms will only be accepted if completed in full and accompanied by payment or proof of payment. Closing date for entries will be the earlier of the 16<sup>th</sup> March 2018 or on a date when the first 180 players have entered.

# 6. Local Rules

Will be issued to players on the date of the tournament.

#### 7. Ties/Count Outs

In cases where two or more players tie for any prize, the result will be determined by the best last round, best score over holes 10 to 18, best score over holes 13-18, best score over holes 16 to 18, best score from hole 18 backwards, all over the last round. Ties for either the ladies or men's gross winner will be determined by sudden death playoff over holes 1.2.17 and 18 repetitively until a winner emerges. If a playoff cannot be completed due to bad light and/or weather, it will be played on the Monday following, from 15:00 onwards.

#### 8. Score Cards

To be handed in at the scoring table in the bar within 10 minutes of completion of the round.

### 9. General Terms and Conditions

- Ladies will not paired with men.
- Only men of age 65 and older, normally playing from the blue tees, will be allowed to enter for the Masters section.
- In case of suspension of play: If round 1 cannot be completed on day 1 and 5 holes or less remain to be played, then round 1 will be completed on day 2, then all

divisions will be cut to 50% of entries who will play round 2 starting at a time as determined by the committee. If round one cannot be completed and more of 5 holes remain to be finished, it will be cancelled and round 2 will determine the result. Should round 2 only not be completed, round 1 result will stand. Should no day be completed, the championship will be replayed on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of April.

- The first 180 players entering will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Requests for preferential times and playing partners will be considered but not guaranteed. Entries open on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2018.
- Sunday will be seeded draw on gross score of round 1, except for the Masters, who will be seeded within their section.
- Any cancellations can only be done at the pro shop.
- Players to report to the starter 15 minutes prior to their starting time.
- Halfway house on both days will be for the player's own account. A maximum of 10 minutes will be allowed in the halfway house.
- It is compulsory to compete on <u>both</u> days. Failure to arrive for an allocated starting time will lead to disciplinary action.
- Any player can win only one prize, except for Seniors and Mid-Amateurs who can
  win an additional one prize in either of these sections. Medal finalist is a subcompetition by itself over the first round only.
- The top 16 players on gross will qualify for the Scratch KnockOut competition.
